### *2015 Black Light ~ White Wine, California*

**Michelle Williams, *Rockin Red Blog*: 2015 Black Light White Wine California:** Make Wine Not War! Whether you are a born again hippie, flower child, or just ready to move past the politics of 2016, this wine is fun for everyone. It comes with a small black light to shine on the bottle; black light off = pure white bottle, but turn on the black light to reveal its true “See the Light” identity. Made from the rare Symphony grape (a cross of Grenache Gris and Muscat of Alexandria from the UC Davis Viticulture Department in 1948) it offers a slight sweetness that is balanced with acidity to make a refreshing, far out wine that pairs perfectly with spicy cuisines, if you can get it away from everyone looking at the bottle in a dark closet.

“**Symphony:** Aromas of lemon verbena, lemon lime, Meyers lemon, Clarey Sage, and rose geranium greet your nose which becomes more apparent as the wine sits in the glass as you play! The color in the glass reminds us of sheer curtains — something there but you can see right through it. On the palate, it’s fruity and light — lots of tropical and exotic fruits. Add to the wine and cheese a pile of games and bunch of friends (encourage them to dress in black light friendly clothes!) and go to it! Grilled cheese game night with Q & A and Black Light wine is a great idea whether you’re gathered at a rainy cabin in the woods, après ski on a snowy mountainside, or on a rainy night at home!
