2014 CABERNET SAUVIGNON ALEXANDER VALLEY

As one of the warmest regions in Sonoma County, Alexander Valley is known for exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon with ripe berry flavors and relatively soft tannins. Our grapes are harvested from a vineyard along the Russian River with views of Chalk Hill, giving it a unique stance at the intersection of three widely acclaimed appellations.

TASTING NOTES:

Blackberry jam aromas up front, very deep and complex. Wisps of white smoke and cedar spice with added fruit notes of black cherry, cassis and a touch of vanilla oak and cocoa powder at the close of the nose. More balanced flavors of blackberry and cherry, a touch of leather and an earthiness mid-palate. Fresh plums with more cedar and oak in the finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS:

This rich and complex Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is especially delicious with braised short ribs.
